Tiffany started her work with animals in 2002, when she was an animal education guide and a dolphin care intern at the Mirage Hotel and Casino in Las Vegas, Nevada. She then went on to work at Six Flags Marine World in Vallejo, California where she trained walrus, dolphins, and a killer whale. At that location, she narrated and performed in over 1,500 public shows at the park. In 2007, Tiffany moved on to work with sea lions as an assistant curator at two different park locations in the Caribbean. While working in St. Kitts, she also conducted an extensive and highly successful search and rescue effort for South American sea lions that had escaped during Hurricane Omar, and rehabilitated them back to health. Tiffany then continued to work abroad, this time at Roatan, Honduras, raising and training sea lions, exotic birds, primates, big cats, reptiles, sharks and sting rays.
