# Dog Obedience Class

**What will be taught?** We will teach you how dogs learn, how to motivate them, communicate to them and work around distractions. We will also teach you to teach your dog how to sit, down, stay, heel (walk on a leash) and come, as well as basic household manners such as, don't jump on people.

**Where is the class?**

**When is the class?** Mondays from 7pm to 8pm. There are six classes, the first class is an orientation without dogs. Please do not bring your dog to the first class.

**Who is invited?** Non-aggressive dogs over 4 months of age. All dogs must be current on vaccines and wearing a rabies tag. Classes are limited to 8 dogs.

**What should I bring?** You may want to take notes during the first class. Classes 2-6 bring a water bowl, treats your dog likes and a leashed, hungry dog.
